



Locket Full Of Moonlight


Released winter 2002 at Pastemusic.com.


Slow Dark Train

Released 1992 on Fingerprint Records. Produced by Mark Heard and Peter Buck of R.E.M. This album really attracted fans to the music of VOL. Every track shines as an acoustic pumped up gem.
